What I'm going to miss...

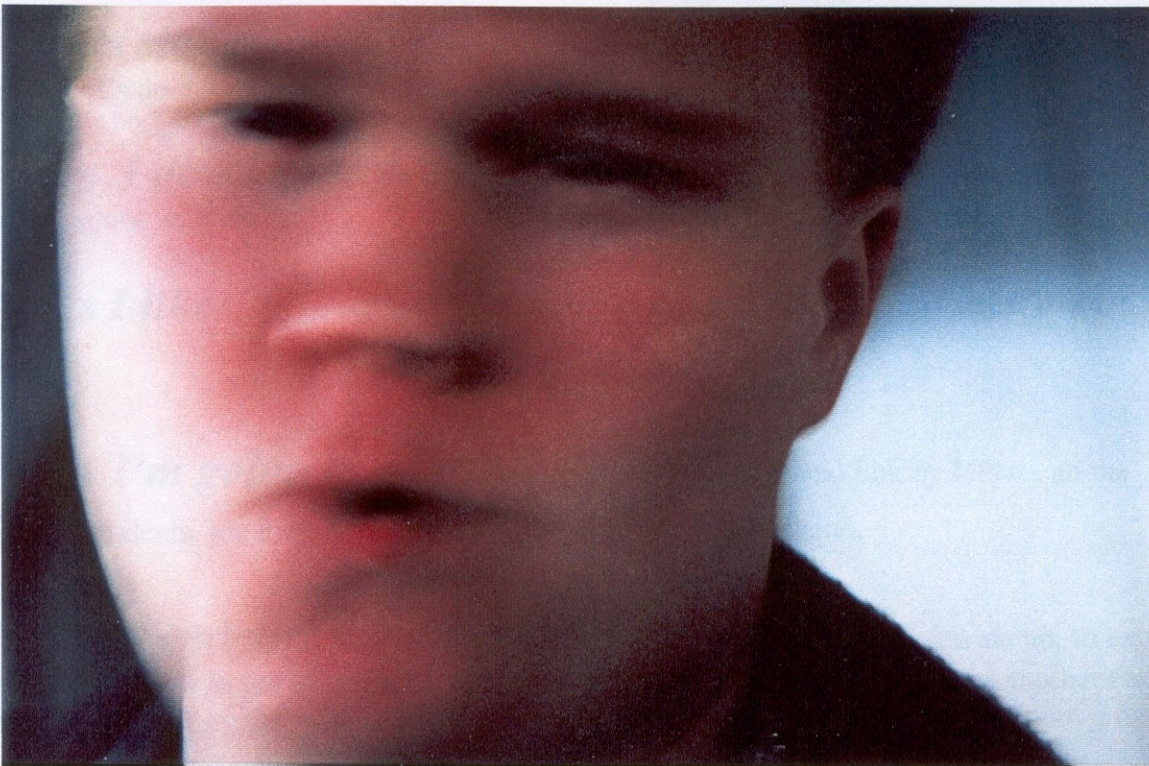
All the nice people I've met here. My car! The fact that I haven't got many obligations here. I'm free. Don't have to worry about grades and stuff.

Things I like:

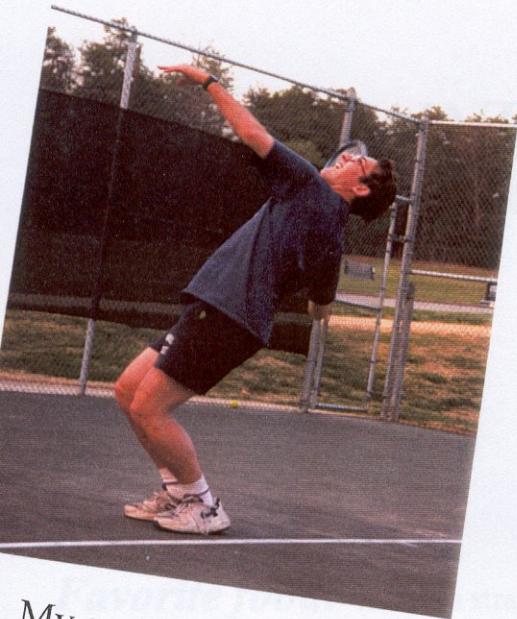

Things I'm goint to miss:

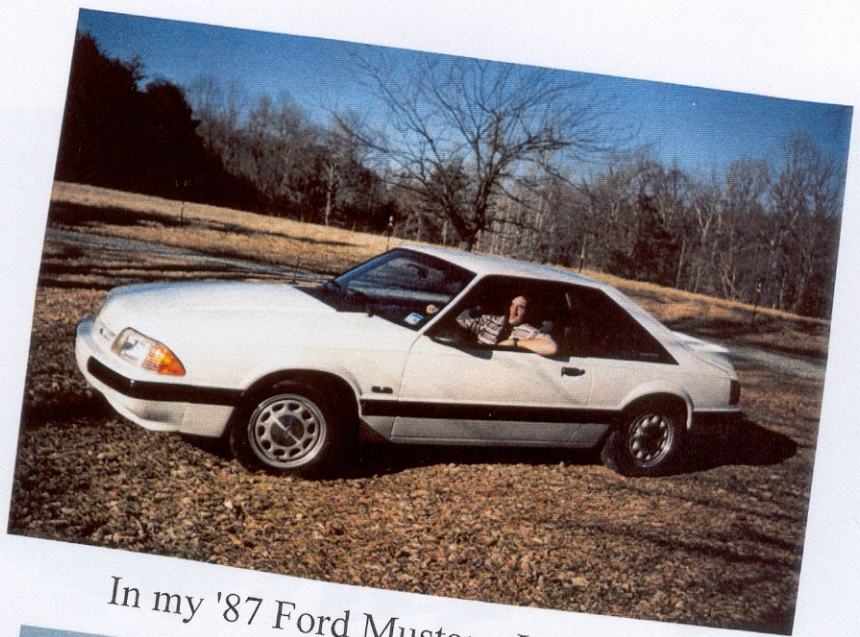
My hostfamily, my international and American friends, my '87 Mustang LX 5.0L, the American way of life, cheap stuff.

Most embarrassing moment:

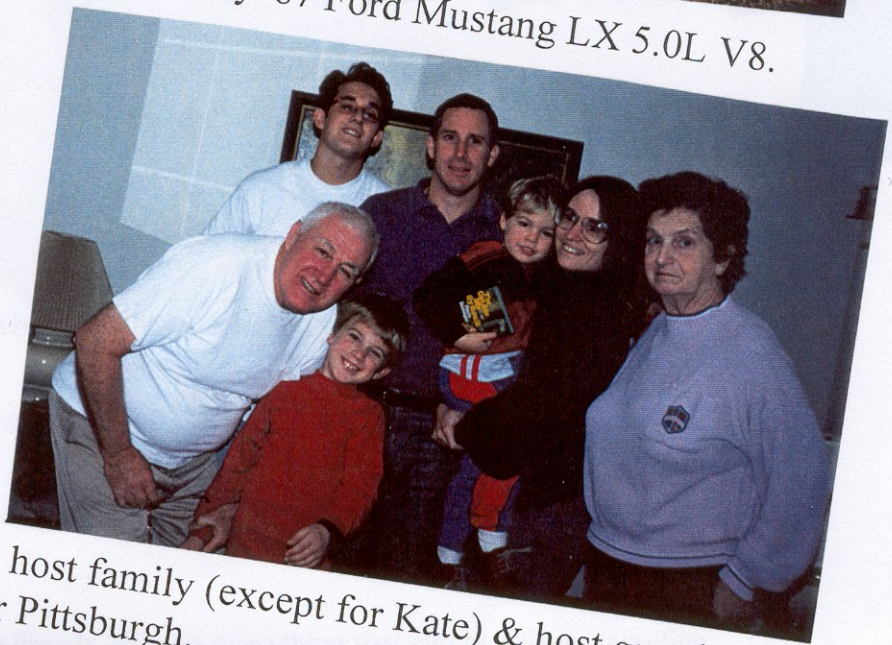
